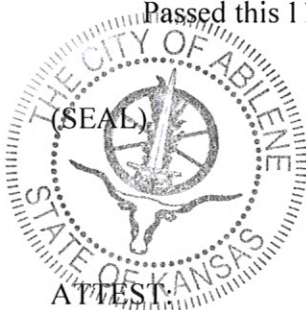


**WHEREAS**, there are no revenue bond ordinances or other ordinances or resolutions of the municipality which require financial statements and financial reports to be prepared in conformity with K.S.A 75-1120a(a) for the year ended December 31, 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Kansas in regular meeting duly assembled this 11th day of January 2021, that the City Commission of Abilene, Kansas, waives the requirements of K.S.A. 75-1120a(a) as they apply to the City of Abilene, Kansas, for the year ended December 31, 2021.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Commission of the City of Abilene, Kansas, shall cause the financial statements and financial reports of the City of Abilene, to be prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements as adjusted to show compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of this State.
