
**PROJECTED POPULATION


URBAN POPULATION






MEDIAN AGE


POPULATION UNDER 18 (DECENNIAL CENSUS)


POPULATION AGE 18 AND OVER (DECENNIAL CENSUS)


POPULATION AGE 65 AND OVER (DECENNIAL CENSUS)

POPULATION AGE 85 AND OVER (DECENNIAL CENSUS)








NUMBER OF HOSPITALS


NUMBER OF HOSPITAL BEDS


ADULT CARE HOMES

ADULT CARE HOMES: NUMBER OF BEDS









MEDIAN VALUE (\$): OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING UNITS






MEDIAN CONTRACT RENT (\$)




POPULATION AGE 25+


PERCENT HS GRADUATE OR HIGHER AGE 25+

ESTIMATED NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN POVERTY




ESTIMATED % OF PEOPLE IN POVERTY


EST. NUMBER OF RELATED CHILDREN AGE 5 TO 17 IN FAMILIES IN POVERTY

EST. % OF RELATED CHILDREN AGE 5 TO 17 IN FAMILIES IN POVERTY






ESTIMATED NUMBER UNDER 18 IN POVERTY

ESTIMATED PERCENT UNDER 18 IN POVERTY





CIVILIAN LABOR FORCE (BLS-Place of Residence; 1990-)





EMPLOYED (BLS-Place of Residence; 1990-)








UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (BLS-Place of Residence; 1990-)



BEA PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME (\$)







HUD MEDIAN FAMILY INCOME






HUD 30% LOW-TO-MEDIUM INCOME (LMI) LIMIT - 4 PERSONS


HUD 50% LOW-TO-MEDIUM INCOME (LMI) LIMIT - 4 PERSONS

HUD 80% LOW-TO-MEDIUM INCOME (LMI) LIMIT - 4 PERSONS






BANK DEPOSITS (1984-2004 in thousands; 2005- in millions)






TANGIBLE ASSESSED VALUATION



CRIME INDEX OFFENSES






PROPERTY CRIMES

VIOLENT CRIMES




NUMBER OF FARMS

TOTAL ACRES HARVESTED






