Meeting Minutes

The Abilene Recreation Commission met on Monday, February 20, 2023 at 6:45a.m. at the Abilene Community Center. Present were Recreation Commission members Derek Berns and Shawn Herrman, and Director Kellee Timbrook. Chris Cease, Angie Evans and Billy Hansen were absent.

Kellee received a resignation letter from Chris Cease resigning from his position on the commission. An update was given on spring and summer programs. Staff was working on the program guide that would be available to the public on March 1. T-ball was discussed. The decision was made to move games to Monday and Wednesday instead of Wednesday and Friday. Soccer, youth baseball and youth softball deadlines were approaching. Kellee would be working on teams, coaches and schedules. Applications were starting to come in for the Recreation Supervisor position. The members were updated on the Comprehensive Plan that the City of Abilene was conducting. There would be a Park Master Plan included in that. Kellee will serve on the steering committee for that. The Sports Complex Task Force received 3 quotes for the feasibility study and economic impact study. This would be taken to the City Commission on March 13 for approval to spend the funds to complete the study.

Having no quorum, no actions were taken.
