

Abilene Recreation Commission
June 27, 2022
Meeting Minutes

The Abilene Recreation Commission met on Monday, June 27, 2022 at 5:00p.m. at the Abilene Community Center. Present were Recreation Commission members Derek Berns, Chris Cease, Angie Evans, Billy Hansen and Director Kellee Timbrook.

Chris Cease, Chair, called the meeting to order. Derek Berns moved to accept the April 18, 2022 meeting minutes as presented, Billy Hansen seconded the motion, motion passed.

Kellee gave the update of the revenue and expense report for the commission through May 2022. Angie Evans made the motion to receive the Financial Report, Billy Hansen seconded the motion, motion passed.

Under old business, tennis court renovations had resumed. The concrete would be poured and expected a 30 day curing period.

Under new business, board member Shawn Herrman was up for re-appointment. He applied for another 4 year term. This would be taken to city commission meeting on July 11 to be approved. Kellee reviewed the 2023 budget with the board. Some expenses had increased due to rise in costs of supplies. It was recommended to stay flat with the 3.35 mill rate. This would exceed the 3.233 revenue neutral rate. The budget hearing and the revenue neutral rate hearing will be held on August 22, 2022 at 6:45am at the Abilene Community Center.

Under the Director's report, Kellee informed members of Parks and Recreation Professional Day on July 15, 2022. City Commission would read a proclamation for this on July 11, 2022 at the city commission meeting. The department would host the Mustang Baseball tournament as well as the AB Softball Tournament this year. Staff was preparing for 4th of July events at the park and the Fall/Winter Program guide.

Having no further business, Derek Berns moved to adjourn the meeting, Billy Hansen seconded the motion, the motion passed.
