

ORDINANCE NO. 25-3466

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-1103 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS PERTAINING TO APPLICATIONS FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTOR LICENSES.

Be it be Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas:

SECTION ONE. Section 3-1103 of the City Code of Abilene, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-1103. Application.

Any person desiring to collect or transport solid or liquid waste within the city shall make application for a license to the City Clerk. The application shall set forth the name and address of the applicant, the make and type of vehicle to be operated for collecting and transporting solid or liquid waste. The application shall be accompanied by:

1. a valid State of Kansas commercial vehicle inspection certificate, or other inspection form approved by the Kansas Highway Patrol, for each such vehicle; and
2. a certificate of insurance evidencing liability coverage for the applicant and each vehicle to be used in the collection or transportation of solid or liquid waste, with minimum limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and naming the City as an additional insured.

SECTION TWO. Existing Section 3-1103 of the City Code of the City of Abilene, Kansas is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:


